WELCOME, FALL!!!

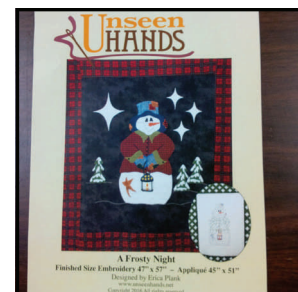
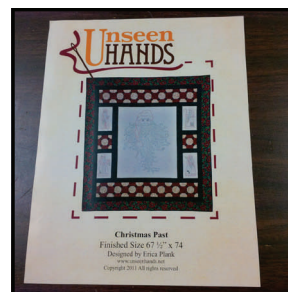
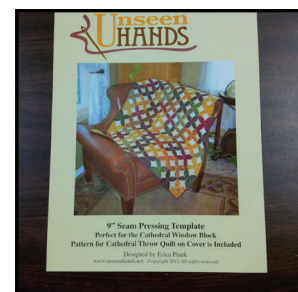
This happy fellow is ready to greet you at our shop to celebrate the new season and share the new and exciting fabrics, patterns, and sewing times

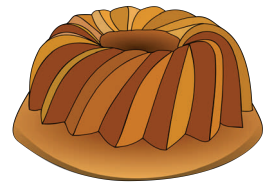
