Sew, What's New at the Shop?

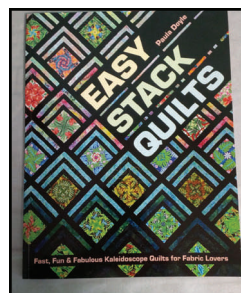


Welcome 2019! We wish our customers and friends all the best for a happy and healthy new year!

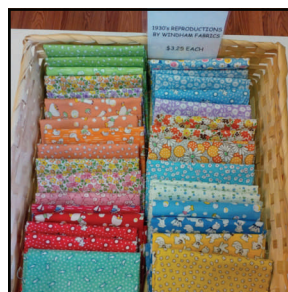


cases for charity. Feel free to join us in this cause by sewing with us on this day. Kits are ready and waiting
