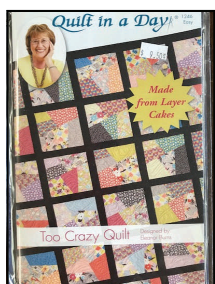
Sew, What's New at the Shop?
